ABOUT THE SONG

•The song was released in 1989.

•It is a list of historical events and personalities from 1949 until 1989.

•The lyrics are proved to be a good summary of the history of that era.

•A lot of references are made to the Cold War, a problem Joel's generation inherited.

The chorus part

There has always been unrest in the world. Nothing done in the recent years is directly responsible for the problems in the world.

The problems stem from events in the past. Each generation attempts to fix the issues of the last.

Nothing is going to have any long term effects.

The video clip

The goal of the American Dream: a home, children and careers

mixed up with the troubled social times of the second half of the 20thcentury.

Steps followed

- asked the students if they had ever heard this song.
- showed them the video clip.
- handed out the copies with the lyrics.
- played the song and they read along.
- •asked them to suggest their own ideas on this project.
- divided them in 6 groups; each one was assigned a separate section to find photos, information etc.
- •encouraged them to make the most of the available resources (history books, school library, the net.)
- asked them to complete the research in a month's time.

AIMS

- To develop language skills.
- · To acquire knowledge through research.
- •To develop a smooth cooperation among them.
- •To communicate information and knowledge.

HOW THE STUDENTS WORKED

- •Looked up in history books to gather information.
- •categorized the items (events, conflicts, culture, athletes, others.)
- **selected** relevant information and pictures from the Internet.
- wrote down a short paragraph for each topic.

- •created six Pp presentations using the photos, one for each section. The Pp presentations were created by the students with learning difficulties.
- •labeled the places of conflicts on a world map.
- •their final product was a flip book with pictures and information.
- •each group taught the class their part of the song.
